The K-Valley District Committee is composed of volunteers from all over K-Valley District. The District serves four functions (known as “FUMP”):

- **Finance:** The District is responsible for raising its share of the Council’s operating budget. This is done through fundraiser events and the Friends of Scouting (FOS) program. Districts also promote good fiscal management practices within Units and Council-provided fundraising opportunities (e.g. the popcorn sale).
- **Unit Service:** The Commissioner team coaches the adult leaders of all Units to promote success. Commissioners drive the annual recharter process and support delivery of Youth Protection training. Commissioners keep an ongoing dialog running with Unit leaders to ensure they have the tools they need to successfully deliver the Scouting program.
- **Membership:** The growth of Scouting depends on the continued expansion of opportunities for youth to participate. Recruitment is an ongoing, year-round endeavor. The Membership team provides tools to drive recruitment of new scouts, and spurs the creation of new Scouting units.
- **Program:** Scouting succeeds on the delivery of a quality program that includes Activities, Advancement, Outdoor Program, and Training. From Pinewood Derby to Camporees, from Scoutmaster Training to Eagle Boards of Review, the Program functions of the District drive the calendar of District-level events.

There are many opportunities to support the Scouting Program at the district level; some of them only requiring a few hours of your time each month. If you are interested in knowing more about these positions, please contact one of the Key 3 listed below.
